ISIS2 Surface Topography

Measuring the three-dimensional shape of your back using a normal digital photograph

- 1. You remove your upper body clothing and loosen your trousers/skirt.
- 2. You tie up your hair, if necessary.
- 3. You put on a black neck band, apron and (for females only) a halter-neck gown to cover your front.
- 4. We place some stickers on certain bony landmarks (Fig. 1).
- 5. We take a digital photograph of your back in ISIS2 (Fig. 2).





Fig. 3 Clinical results

- 6. The computer analyses the photograph and produces clinical results (Fig. 3).
- 7. We remove the stickers and you get dressed.
